

Trick or Treat in Hamel Set for Saturday, Oct 31st from 5-8pm

This year the Village of Hamel residents may participate in Trick or Treat on Halloween night, Saturday, Oct. 31st, from 5 to 8 pm.

We are strongly recommending following the guidelines set by the Illinois Department of Public Health for Trick or Treat.

Trick or Treat is voluntary. If you do not wish to participate, please do not turn your porch light, or other outdoor lights on the night of Halloween.

The Hamel Police Department will once again have extra patrols for Trick or Treat. They will be handing out glow necklaces and asking everyone to follow the safety recommendations.

Wear a mask or face covering while Trick or Treating. Do not rely on the mask from a costume, and check to make sure costume masks

and face coverings can be worn together. Mask wearing for those passing out treats is recommended.

Pass out treats outside if possible. Set up a table and place individual treats on the table for Trick or Treaters to take. Do not allow Trick or Treaters to reach into a bowl to take treats.

Mark spaces for social distancing on your sidewalk or driveway. Help Trick or Treaters practice social distancing at your house.

Wash your hands. Whether you are getting Treats or passing them out, bring hand sanitizer with you and wash your hands. Wash them again before having any treats.

Only households should Trick or Treat together. This year group Trick or Treating is being discouraged.

Things to Consider for Fall & Winter Months



The burning of yard waste is permitted by Village ordinance on **Fridays and Saturdays from October through February.**

The burning of any other type of waste is strictly prohibited. For leaf burning on days other than provided by the ordinance, you may obtain a burn permit from the Village Hall.

With freezing temperatures on the way, please remember to disconnect and drain any garden hoses or above ground sprinklers you may have connected to outside faucets.

Freezing temperatures can cause hoses and sprinklers to crack and start leaks that can be difficult to detect until a significant amount of water has been lost.

- **Wipe off candy wrappers**
